CMS 7.2.002.SP8 Release Notes

New Features:

- Traffic eCitation - A "Duplicate the last case entered" button has been added to the Case Entry screen.
- Traffic eCitation - Allow the user to enter an Incident Number if there is no Incident Number when the Citation is pulled in from SCDMV.
- Traffic eCitation - A Social Security Number (SSN) field has been added to the Case Entry screen.
- Traffic eCitation - SC Driver's License Lookup has been added to the Drivers' License No field.
- Expungement: When a user tries to expunge a disposed case, CMS now checks for an Existing eDisposition error for the case. If no error exists, the case can be Expunged. If an eDisposition error exists, the error is displayed and the case cannot be Expunged.
- CMS Navigation menus: Case Manager, Table Manager, Reports Manager, and Options Manager menus have been updated to support the Touch Screen feature. : .
- The DMV-NRVC Interface Universal Interface Parameters now has a flag to disable/enable the DMV Failure To Pay (FTP) interface.

Enhancements:

- Hearing Data: CMS is now tracking the activity levels of Judges through Case Roster, Motion Roster, and Summary Court Docket hearings.
- Hearing Data: Table Manager has been updated to include the Report As field which is used to identify Hearing data. This field has been added to Scheduling in the following locations: Case Roster Types, Motion Roster Type, and Resources.
- GS & MIE: Case Roster: A case can now exist on multiple case rosters at the same time for GS and MIE if the roster type is not the same.
- Hearing Data: A case can now exist on multiple Summary Court Dockets if the dockets are not the same docket type.
- Report Manager / Docket Reports / Disposed Cases: The case subtype has been added back to the data displayed in the Disposed Cases Report.

Bug Fixes:

- Traffic eCitation: When e-citation pulls in a statute that is an exact match for multiple CDR codes, the user can now choose one of the charges. If the statute is not valid, the user can choose a new statute.
- Traffic eCitation: When a case created using Traffic eCitation is deleted, the eCitation Audit Log records are now also deleted.
- Traffic eCitation: If the user changes a statute to one with multiple CDR codes after first entering an invalid statute and double-clicking the statute field, the behavior now correctly responds to the new entry.
- Traffic eCitation: The User no longer receives 'A Valid Docket is Required' Error message when a Valid Docket is selected.
- Case Manager / Charges / Offense / Amend the charge: When a record with the non-default Statute code is selected, the Amend Charge correctly returns the selected non-default statute.
- GS Case Entry: When a case is created with a non-default statute, the created case now has the correct statute, instead of the default statute.
- SC Parking Ticket: When a case is created with a non-default statute, the created case now has the correct statute, instead of the default statute.
- Report Manager / Case Status / Warrant/Civil Case Transmittal: When updating the status of warrants, a Warning prompt now appears with 'Yes' option to proceed with the status update, or 'No' option to Cancel the update.
- Case NRVC record: When a Balance is set to zero, the Date paid in full, and Payment Received are set.
- Case Manager / Charge Screen: When Green Check is clicked, the status on any Applied Sentence Sheet will not be changed to Deleted.
- When adding a 3% collection fee to a case in Case Manager / Fines/Costs screen, the total amount is now used when calculating the 3% collection fee.
- In Case Manager / Case Parties, the First name now properly displays the name of the Case Parties.
- The System no longer allows for a Disposition and Judgment Date to be entered with a date before the Case filed date.
